

Registration

- Pre-registration and payment is required for all activities, except where noted.
- Activities are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Registration forms are available on line, in the office, or in the Program Guide.

Refunds and Cancellations

NWCPRD reserves the right to cancel any activity for which there is insufficient registration, or for any other reasonable cause, such as inclement weather. Refunds are issued for programs that NWCPRD decides to cancel. Please note that refunds take a minimum of three weeks for processing.

Scholarships

NWCPRD has a scholarship fund that can assist qualifying youths. A limited number of scholarships are available for each program. Please call the office to see if your family qualifies for a scholarship.

Out-of-district Fee Policy

The NWCPRD Board of Directors has adopted an Out-of-district Fee Policy. The intent of this fee policy is to establish fair and equitable fees and charges for use of district facilities and programs by Park District and non-Park District users.

Persons living outside the Northern Wasco County Parks & Recreation District boundary are charged an additional fee. The Non-Resident Fee is 10% applied to all programs, including pool admission.

People who live and/or own property within the NWCPRD boundaries support the parks and recreation services through their property taxes; therefore, the district offers in-district residents early registration.

Required Residency Information:

Residency Cards are proof of a person's residency in the District. Cards are free and valid for one year to homeowners or renters/others. Replacements cards are \$5. If you are not sure whether you are a resident, check your property tax bill or call the Parks office, 541-296-9533.

To obtain a Residency Card, please provide the following:

1. Completed Proof of Residency Form (available online or in our office)
2. Valid form of ID, such as: Current Oregon driver's license, Oregon identification card
3. One of the following (it must be current and have your address printed on it):

Property tax statement

Utility bill (gas, electric, telephone, water)

Insurance card

Bank or credit card statement

Lease agreement
